

## Current Interventions

At Webheath we are very lucky in that we have specialised Teaching Assistants who offer either 1:1 intervention or small group work in the following areas:-

**Maths** – Our maths intervention supports children who require additional help with specific mathematical concepts or to consolidate their learning. This intervention follows First Class number programme.

**Speech and Language** – Our speech and language interventions are bespoke and follow advice from external professionals such as Speech and Language Therapists or from an individual assessment analysis such as Speech and Language Link.

**Rapid Phonics** – This intervention supports children who require extra support learning or applying their phonics knowledge.

**Rapid Reading** – This intervention is offered to children who require additional help with reading. This may be support in recognising sight words, improving fluency or comprehension.

**Social and Emotional** – This intervention has been specifically created for children who find social situations difficult or have emotional/personal issues to deal with. These practical sessions may include Social Stories, role play, problem solving, group activities and talking.

**Developmental Co-ordination Disorder (DCD)** - Some children find gross and fine motor skills tricky and need some support in developing stronger muscles. This intervention follows the 'Jimbo Fun' programme. This includes practical activities inside and outside (weather permitting), handwriting practice, mark-making and other activities designed to improve posture and muscles strength.

We are very lucky at Webheath to have an army of volunteers who come into school weekly to hear children read on a 1:1 basis.
